# PRE-EYELASH EXTENSIONS APPOINTMENT MANUAL

# LASHES 101



01

Be aware the eyelash extensions must stay dry for the first 24 hours after your appointment. Please plan your showers and other water based activities accordingly.

02

Please remove all eye makeup, including mascara, prior to your appointment. Eye makeup affects the adhesive bond and reduces how long your extensions can last.

03

Do not rub-on face creams or sunblock on the portion of the eyes that is to be treated. Many moisturizers contain oils that prevent adhesives from sticking to the natural eyelash and shorten the lifespan of the eyelash extensions.

04

Do not curl eyelashes prior to appointment. This will disrupt the application process.

05

Avoid caffeine and other stimulants prior to your lash appointment. Caffeine and stimulants may put you in an agitated state, preventing you from becoming still and relaxed during your appointment.

06

Please remove contact lenses prior to your appointment.

# 07

Dress comfortably. Generally, appointments last over an hour, wear something that will allow you to lie down in a relaxed, non-restricted manner.

Go to the bathroom before your appointment, to ensure you are comfortable.

# 09

If you like, bring headphones to listen to music during your appointment. Although many eyelash extension customers fall asleep during the procedure, music can help enhance the relaxing experience provided.

### 10

If you currently have eyelash extensions make this known prior to your appointment. This may require a lash removal service in addition to your appointment. To ensure the procedure runs smoothly and time is accounted for, this must be known prior to booking.

### 11

Be prepared to put your phone on silent mode during the extension application. Communication in the treatment location is not advised because precision is required in the process.

### 12

Upon arrival of your first appointment, be prepared to fill out the client intake and consent form.

### 13

Acceptable forms of payment include cash, zelle, and venmo.
